GENERAL INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the American Society of Naval Engineers (ASNE) Scholarship Program is to improve the profession of naval engineering by encouraging college students to enter the field of naval engineering and by providing support to naval engineers seeking advanced education in the field. The society awards scholarships to students for the last year of an undergraduate program or for one year of a graduate program.

Examples of the programs of study which apply to the diverse field of Naval Engineering are naval architecture, marine, ocean, mechanical, structural, civil, environmental, aeronautical, electrical and electronic engineering, and the physical sciences, as well as other programs leading to careers with both military and civilian organizations requiring these educational backgrounds. Naval Engineering includes the design, construction and repair of ships and their installed systems and equipment, as well as research, logistic support, and the management of acquisition and maintenance.

The scholarship award amounts are \$3,000 for undergraduate students and \$4,000 for graduate students. The number of scholarships awarded each year is based on funding availability. Selection criteria include the candidate's academic record, work history, professional promise and interest in naval engineering, extracurricular activities, as well as recommendations of college faculty, employers, and other character references. Financial need may also be considered.

All sections of this application must be completed for consideration. The following criteria also apply:

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
2. Scholarships are limited to support during the last academic year of undergraduate education or during one year of graduate education leading to a master's degree in an accredited college or university. Scholarships will not be awarded to doctoral candidates or to applicants already holding advanced degrees.
3. Undergraduate candidates must be full-time students or currently participating in a co-op program. Graduate students must be full-time students. Graduate applicants must also be ASNE members.
4. Applications, transcripts, and letters of reference must be received no later than 12 February. Letters of reference are to be signed by the writer, sealed and mailed to the Society or attached to this application.
5. Only the completed application, transcripts, and three letters of reference will be evaluated. No other information is required or desired; responses should be confined to the space provided. All materials should be sent to the address shown above.
